Your child in <u>Grades P-6</u> and their teacher are inviting you to attend a conversation about your child's Learning on:

Tuesday 26 AUGUST between 8:30am - 6:00 pm

Learning Talks involve your child's teacher, you (the parent/guardian) and your child. During the 15 minute time slot, you will be able to have an open conversation about how your child is going **socially**, **emotionally** and **academically** at school. Our teachers will support you to ask the questions that you want the answers to.

You have the opportunity to have our **Visible Learning Walls** for Literacy and Numeracy explained, a journey of learning where your child tracks where they are in the learning cycle of "**What I know**", "**What I am learning now**" and "**What I am learning next**".

Whilst attending the Learning Talks, any siblings will be cared for in a Crèche in the School's Library.


